## Risala Chowdhury - DMYP

Year 10 student Risala Chowdhury (pictured on front cover) recently beat off competition from five other candidates in the area to be named Deputy Member of Youth Parliament for Bury St Edmunds and West Suffolk

“It feels absolutely amazing to have won, I’m really happy to represent my constituents and know I have the strategies and skills to do that. I know I can make a change in Suffolk,” she said.

The Youth Parliament election took place from 5th - 9th March and had almost 5,000 young people vote. On-line West Suffolk saw the most votes cast.

Risala will now act as deputy to Kathir Parthipan, from Samuel Ward Academy, who is the new Member of Youth Parliament for the area. Risala hopes to prioritise discrimination against minorities and help to educate young people on issues faced by other teens like her. “I experience the effects of discrimination and I want to change that. I just want to speak from my own mind. I think as long as I do that, people will be motivated and they will listen,” she said.



## James Peck - Cross Country

James Peck of Year 8 recently travelled to Leeds to represent Suffolk in the English Schools’ Cross Country Championship. James was competing in the Junior Boys category for Year 8 and 9 students and finished 40th out of 347 runners, which is an outstanding achievement.



In the team event, the finishing places for the top six runners in each county are added together to give a total team score. The lower the score, the higher the finishing position. James and his Suffolk team mates finished 2nd of 45 counties the best ever result for Suffolk in this category.


