

Mobile Phone Procedure

This procedure is reviewed every three years. It can be reviewed sooner if amendments to legislation or educational practice necessitate a change.





- Mobile phones are not allowed to be used by students for social activity during the academy day.
- Whilst we accept that students may carry a mobile phone on journeys to and from the academy, they are not to be used on our academy sites at any time unless part of an agreed supervised teacher led activity.
- Should a student use their mobile phone during the academy day without permission then the mobile phone will be confiscated and taken to reception to be stored securely. In the first instance students will be able to collect their mobile phone at the end of the day.
- Any subsequent instances will require a parent/carer to collect the mobile phone.
- Persistent violations of this rule will mean the student is not allowed to bring their mobile phone into the academy or will need to hand it in before the start of the day.
- Refusal to hand over a mobile phone when requested to do so by a member of staff will be seen as defiance and gross misconduct issued.
