E-Vouchers / Suffolk County Council Verification / Eequ

This holiday Suffolk County Council is using a new booking system called **Eequ** – **Please read these details carefully.** All bookings will now go through the **Eequ** system and a verification check before they are confirmed.

All children registered as <u>means tested free school meals</u> will already have their details entered into the **Eequ** booking system.

- Parents will book their children through the online links using **Eequ** if their child is on the Suffolk County Council list, they will get instant approval and will receive a confirmation email.
- If they are not on the system, (or they type a name or date of birth incorrectly) there request for a ticket will be sent to Suffolk County Council for approval.
- Approvals will not start until after 28th November and will take up to 3 days if they are approved, they will receive a booking confirmation if they are rejected, they will receive a cancellation and explanation of why.
- Parents need to understand their booking is not confirmed and they are not eligible for a place until they have received their booking confirmation email.

Free sessions are primarily for children entitled to **Free School Meals** – Approval will also be considered for young people in the following categories:

- Eligible for free school meals Pupil Premium (Not KS1 universal free school meals)
- Looked after child (LAC)
- Child protection plan in place
- Refugees
- Young carers


