#### Warm;Strict Ethos Update

Thankyou to all parents and carers for your continued support in ensuring that your child is on time and smartly dressed in the MCA uniform. We have had another fantastic week with a large number of positive rewards being recorded. Last week I announced a random 'Wow Wednesday' prize draw. Any student in Years 7-11 who did not receive a late mark or consequence throughout the day was eligible to be chosen randomly. 994 students were eligible for the prize. Using a random number generator, a student in Year 8 was selected and given a £20 Amazon gift voucher. I want to make it clear that consistent hard work and excellent behavior for learning over time is even more important and our rewards policy addresses this as students accumulate TRAITS which equate to gift vouchers, certificates and badges. We regularly reward students in our House Assemblies which take place every fortnight too.

We are delighted that we have a much lower number of detentions being issued to students at present. Our consequence and sanction system exists to serve as a deterrent and it is fantastic that the vast majority of our students are not being sanctioned. If your child does receive a C2 and a resulting detention, please contact your child's tutor in the first instance if you have any questions or concerns. We can work together to develop support strategies and interventions to avoid further consequences.

Mr Goodenough will be in contact soon to share a new service with parents and carers so that you can view our weekly values assemblies. We think this will be an excellent way to develop our communication with parents and carers so that we can continue to strengthen our working partnership. *Mr Oxley*
