Just a short set of notices from me this week. I hope that all students, parents and carers have had a restful half term. I know that the return to school after a break can be busy and the run up to Christmas can be exciting but challenging for others. Please be assured that we will continue to look for the positives this half term and will champion the work and efforts of all students where warranted. I also want to make you aware of some changes to expectations and routines at lunch:

Year 8 do not need to line up after Lunch: This is because we want to maximise learning time in the afternoon. The 'line up' was taking time to complete as many teachers needed to arrive straight from teaching a lesson during period 3ii. The corridor congestion issue has been assessed and we believe that Year 8 and Year 10 students moving into the building after lunch should be able to do so safely. The line up for Year 7 and Year 8 after break is important as many year groups are moving back into the building and into lessons. The Year 7 line up after first lunch will continue for this reason also.

Students can eat on the Field at Break and Lunch: After careful consideration of the views expressed by a significant number of students we will be allowing students to eat on the field during break and lunch times. Clear expectations and conditions will be shared by me in my values assembly this week with regular reminders in Morning Meetings. Bins will now be placed on the field so that students can use them. Students can eat freely to the sides of the field well away from ball games.
