# Uniform

Thankyou to Parents and Carers who continue to support our uniform policy. We have seen a noticeable improvement this week with blazers being worn and fewer incidences of leggings being worn. With the colder weather, it really is advisable for students to wear a jacket or coat over their blazer, rather than a hoodie under their blazer. Students are expected to remove their hoodies before they enter the building at the start of the day. This cannot be worn later in the day, so I would be concerned if students did not have a suitable warm layer that they could wear at break or lunch.

The branded jumpers are a suitable extra layer that can be worn under the blazer and look smart. Previously we have also allowed students to wear an MCA-branded PE fleece under their blazer during cold weather and whilst there were supply issues involving the jumper. Some staff have enquired as to whether this arrangement could be reinstated. I am happy for students to wear a branded fleece under their blazer until half term during these colder weeks. I hope that this adjustment is helpful. I will provide a uniform update when we return after half term.

## **Aerosols and Fragrance Sprays**

There have been some concerns raised by students and staff regarding the use of aerosols and spray fragrances in the Academy. Many schools have taken the step to ban the use of aerosols and sprays due to the risks they can pose to individuals with asthma or other respiratory conditions. Alternative roll-on fragrance products are readily available so the ban of aerosols and spray fragrances should not be of detriment to anyone in our Academy community. The restriction applies to all community members- including adults and all members of staff. Please can you support us in restricting the use of such products during the school day by ensuring that your child does not bring a spray product into the Academy. Such items will be confiscated if seen outside of a student's bag. The item will then be given to Student Reception and can be collected by a parent/carer if the student wishes to have the item back. Thank you in advance for your support to ensure that we can keep our community members safe.

#### **SEND Coffee Morning**

We are holding our next SEND Coffee Morning of the year on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> January between 10am and 11.30am. This is an opportunity for parents of SEND students to informally meet with members of the SEND team and chat with other parents as a support network.

For this term's coffee morning, we also have staff from Suffolk SENDIASS and MHST joining us. SENDIASS are a confidential advice service for parents of students with SEND needs and MHST are our local Mental Health in Schools team. Both will have staff at our coffee morning who will be available for parents/carers to talk to about the support they can offer for students and their families.



The event will take place at our MCA6 Sixth Form site. Please come to the MCA6 main reception where you will be shown through to the lecture theatre.
