


Changes to the Medical Room

Information for Students



From Monday 3rd March - for all students

- The Medical Room will be closed during lesson times.
- You must not leave lessons if you are feeling unwell or request medical.
 There will be nobody there and staff will not give you permission to leave.
- The only exception is for diabetic students who may need to test blood sugars in the medical room during lesson time.
- If you take medication at a set time every day, this will be brought to your classroom at the required time. You do not need to leave. If you are concerned, you should ask the teacher to send an alert to medical.

What about at breaktime or lunchtime?

- If you are feeling unwell, you can go to the Medical Room at Break or Lunch but must go at the beginning.
- If you arrive at Medical towards the end, you will be asked to go to your lesson and the teacher will request Medical to come to you.
- If you require First Aid at Break or lunch (e.g. plaster, bandage) you will be seen in the medical room regardless of the time.

If you are asked to wait for medical to arrive but walk out...

- The Medical rooms will be closed as staff will be mobile and visiting classes.
- You will get help quicker and won't need to wait as long in a queue and miss out on learning time.
- Please remember that leaving a lesson without permission is a Gross Misconduct (GM) sanction.

What about needing the toilet?

- Only students with a Toilet Pass are allowed out of class to go to the toilet.
- You should remember to go at break and lunchtime, and if desperate, quickly between lessons but do not make yourself late.
- If your teacher feels it is absolutely necessary for you to leave and go to the toilet- you must use the nearest toilets to the classroom. Please do not go to a different floor.

<u>REMINDER</u>

You are not allowed to leave lessons for Medical.
