Social media and Group Chats

We are seeing an increase in issues brought into school as a result of some unkind behaviour on social media and group chats. We would like to ask for the support of parent/carers in monitoring their children's social media use to ensure that it is appropriate and not emotionally harmful to themselves or others.

In particular, we would like to remind you that platforms such as Whatsapp, TikTok, Snapchat and Instagram have age limits of 13+. If you allow your child to access these platforms, we ask you to be increasingly vigilant and monitor their use.

We are also aware of some group chats that have been created with names such as "Year 7 MCA Group Chat," with over 100 students who have joined. These groups are in no way affiliated with or monitored by the school, and large chats can be breeding grounds for unkind behaviour. We recommend that you check whether your child is a member of any larger groups and remove themselves, or that you monitor the content.
