#### Sparx Reader

As part of our ongoing commitment to developing strong reading habits, all students in years 7, 8 and 9 are expected to complete their weekly homework using Sparx Reader. Each week, students should achieve 300 Sparx Reader Points (SRP).

Reading is one of the most important skills your child can develop, not only supporting their academic progress across all subjects but also fostering imagination, empathy, and a lifelong love of learning. To gain the greatest benefit, we encourage students to spend 5–10 minutes reading each day, rather than leaving their homework until the day before it is due. This helps to build a consistent routine and ensures deeper understanding of the texts.







Sparx Reader carefully selects books that are matched to each student's individual reading age, while still allowing students to change books if they are not finding their current choice engaging. This flexibility helps to keep reading both accessible and enjoyable.

Class teachers will be closely monitoring students' progress, including their SRP completion, time spent reading, accuracy, and reading speed (words per minute). This information will allow us to provide support where needed and celebrate success.

Students can login to Sparx Reader (Sparx Reader - Home) using either their Microsoft 365 details or by using their Sparx Reader username and password. Each student's username is their first name and surname E.g. sherlockholmes and students can set their own password by clicking the 'Forgot login details'.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us build positive reading habits together. By encouraging your child to engage with Sparx Reader daily, you are helping them to make real and lasting progress.
