Year 10 Work Experience

We're looking forward to Year 10 work experience, which begins on 27th April. The team at MCA are currently finalising arrangements, and we'd like to share a few important reminders with you.



If your child does not have a placement:

They should attend the academy as normal, including students who only have placements for part of the week. Some lessons may be combined with other classes during this time.

If your child has a placement:

- If your child is unwell and unable to attend, please inform both the placement provider and the academy as soon as possible.
- Please check with your child that all steps for their placement have been completed on Grofar.

Some students still need to complete parts of the process:

- 2 out of 7 stages completed → parental consent is still needed
- 3 out of 7 stages completed → the employer still needs to give consent
- 6 out of 7 stages completed → your child is ready to attend

Students must have completed 6 out of 7 stages in order to take part in work experience next week.
