Consultation Outcome

I hope that everyone has seen the consultation outcome letter that was released on Thursday 21st May. A copy is attached for your reference again. A detailed justification of the decisions made is included in the letter along with common questions and answers. Here is a brief summary of the changes agreed:

- The October half term break will be one week in duration- so there is no change.
- The school day will run from 0855-1540.
- There will be five lessons per day which will be 60-65 minutes in duration.



- Wednesday Period 5 will be an optional enrichment lesson. Students can sign up for activities/lessons if they wish to. Otherwise, students can leave at 1440.
- Buses are aligned to our new timings on all 5 days of the week. This includes public bus services.

I would like to thank all community members who engaged with the consultation. These changes are intended to improve the quality of our education provision whilst providing wellbeing and enrichment opportunities.

Further details will be share throughout this final half term of the Academic year. We will ensure that students feel informed and supported with regards to the changes being implemented. We appreciate that change can feel overwhelming and challenging so we will ensure that students have an opportunity to share concerns and ask questions.
