Uniform Arrangements WB 29/6/26

We will revert to the normal Summer uniform expectations as the forecasted temperature is back down to the mid-20's for the week. Just a reminder of the following-

- Black tailored shorts (with no branding) for male or female students
- White shirt as normal
- Kilt at an appropriate length- at or just above the knee
- Tie as normal- although teachers may direct students to take them off if classrooms are hot.
- Black shoes/trainers- not sliders/crocs or anything other than a proper shoe/trainer
- Neutral-coloured thin socks- not 'puffy 80's style'

Blazers are not required for the remainder of the term. Leggings/'fleggings' or other skin tight thin fabrics are still not permitted. New Mobile Phone Policy- WB 29th June

We appreciate that a big change lies ahead next week with the introduction of phone pouches. I have attached the previous letters again. Please be mindful of the **high-level sanctions due to the legal requirements** placed upon all schools. I have included a few key points about the new policy:

- The pouches have been provided **free of charge** whilst many other schools are passing the cost to parents/carers
- Pouches have been chosen to minimise disruption to the school day. Some schools are using lockers and have reduced social time to allow for supervised locking and collection. Our system is **designed to minimise disruption and save time**.
- We want to save time with this system. **Please ensure that your child brings in their phone as normal** so that they can start using their pouch and get used to the system.

- **Unlocking is really quick and easy.** We have lots of well-spaced unlocking stations. These will remain unlocked from 1520- until the following morning. If a pouch gets locked accidentally before Morning Meeting- students can use the unlocking stations.
